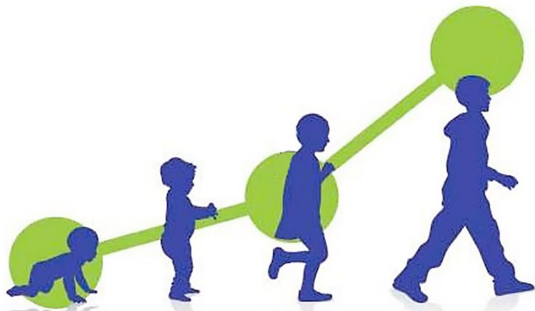


## Six Commitments to Child Well-Being

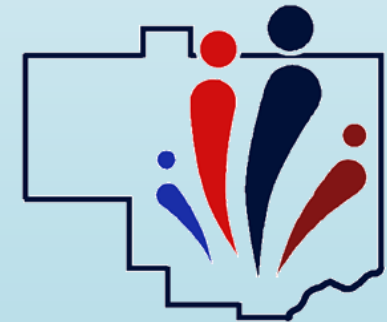

## FCFC Priorities:

### Shared Planning

#### Systems Level Service Coordination

- To improve outcomes for youth and families experiencing trauma
- To support high-risk, multi system youth



### Infants and Toddlers

#### Help Me Grow – Home Visiting

- Voluntary family support program for pregnant women or new parents
- Promotes healthy growth and development for babies and toddlers
- Non-judgmental and compassionate approach that empowers parents



#### Help Me Grow – Early Intervention

- Coordinated services to parents of eligible children under the age of three with developmental delays or disabilities
- Team develops a coordinated Individualized Family Service Plan (IFSP)
- The plan uses existing supports and resources and builds upon them



### Service Coordination

#### Information and Referral

- Families and partner agencies are invited to contact FCFC for assistance locating needed information and services for children

#### Family Support Team Meetings

- Facilitated team approach to helping families experiencing crisis or possible out of home placement

### Case Reviews

- Next level team approach bringing together the existing team and representatives from the county service systems to brainstorm creative options to help families facing out of home placement, reunification, or other high risk factors



### OhioRISE Program

#### – formerly (Wraparound)

- Assists families with the referral and eligibility process for accessing services
- Provides a “warm handoff” to help families transition from FCFC
- Provides Wraparound services to a small number of families found to be ineligible for OhioRISE
